To Collectors of Customs and Excise,
and others concerned:

"Made in Canada" Rulings.

From information before the Department, the following are now of a class or kind made in Canada:-

Cleaning compound in plastic form, commonly known as wall paper cleaner, for cleaning wall paper, painted walls, window shades, etc.

Corrugated wood-joint fastener strip of steel, with plain or with saw edge, also known as wiggle nails.

NOTE: This ruling transferring these goods from the category of "a class or kind not made in Canada" to that of "a class or kind made or produced in Canada" is issued in accordance with the Government's undertaking to give "adequate notice" to parties concerned, and is to be effective three weeks from the date hereof.
