merger with the three possible CLC unions,
WHEREAS the CCU, SORWUC, and continued direct CLC affiliation attempts have been investigated,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the AUCE Special Convention set the following referendum ballot on this matter:

- I. A four-part union-wide referendum commence as soon as possible and be conducted until 5:00 p.m. May 29, 1980 and counted on May 30, 1980.
- II. Final ratification of any negotiations with another labour body shall be approved or rejected by the AUCE membership by referendum ballot.
- III. That each local's ballots be printed on different coloured paper and tabulated separately, local by local.
