In reply to your inquiry of February 26. I have pleasure in enclosing herewith text of the "Provisional Trade Agreement and Payments Agreement between Canada and Germany".

Although originally it was provided that. barter transactions would be permissible for a period of. six months from November 15th, I have been informed by competent German quarters that owing to the large number of applications for barter business which had been filed in Germany, further applications have no prospects of being granted. In other words, the German exports to Canada are to be paid for by straight foreign exchange (Devisen).
