INTRODUCTION

Born in 1917, Angus Macphee had a long period of union activity, mainly in the Prince Rupert area, prior to the formation of the Pulp & Paper Workers of Canada in 1963. He was First Vice-President of the national organization, 1964-67, and Secretary-Treasurer, 1968-69. The organization changed its name to the Pulp, Papers and Woodworkers of Canada in 1971 and he became business agent and national board members for Local No. 4 (Prince Rupert), 1971-1976. Angus Macphee served as national President, 1977-1982.

His papers includes records relating to the International Brotherhood of Pulp, Sulphite and Paper Mill Workers (IBPS & PMO) Local 708 (Prince Rupert), including Committee of Inquiry and Rank and File Movement for Democratic Action, 1953-1967. Records include correspondence, circular letters, clippings, and newsletters with the International executive and representative and other locals relating to autonomy, raiding, negotiations, economics, labour research and education, health and safety, dissident movements within the International and other topics as well as serials such as The Amplifier, Clean-Upp, The Rebel and Union Democracy in Action. Records of the Pulp, Paper and Woodworkers of Canada (formerly Pulp & Paper Workers of Canada) including convention material and national executive board minutes, 1963-1970, constitutional matters, 1963-83, and correspondence pertaining to national organizing, "bugging" inquiry, certifications and

negotiations, 1965-75. In addition, Angus Macphee collected a series of constitutions of the Western Canada Council of Pulp and Paper Mill Unions, 1958-1964. Minutes and correspondence of the Prince Rupert Labour Council, 1952-1961 have also been collected by Macphee as part of his duties.
