Strike Committee Report (following Contract Committee report - assuming the membership turns down the University's latest offer)

Now that we have turned down the U's latest offer, we must now consider what action we can take to force them to up their "ante". It is our opinion that we should serve them with 72-hour strike notice. When should we serve that strike notice?

There are varying opinions, and they are as follows:

asap - because when the 72-hour notice has passed a ban on overtime is legal. we can then decide what to do - we will probably start small (see back)

✓ 5 MOTION: that the memb. authorize spending up to \$300 on picket signs.

✓ 1 MOTION: that the membership of AUCE Local 1 authorizes the Strike Committee to serve 72-hour strike notice on _____.

Now that we have decided to serve strike notice, there are a few things that we must deal with and the strike committee has moved and seconded the following motions:

✓ 2 MOTION: that the membership of AUCE Local 1 hereby authorizes the secretary-treasurer to pay strike pay only to those members who perform picket/or alternate duty. In the event that a member performs some of her/his duty, but not all, the rate of pay will be on a pro rata basis.

✓ 4 MOTION: that the membership of AUCE Local 1 hereby authorizes the secretary-treasurer to borrow funds up to and including \$50,000 to pay strike pay, in the event that the strike fund is depleted.

✓ 3 MOTION: that the membership authorize paid union leave for 2 people to co-ordinate the strike. *roughly \$40/person*

Now that these motions have been passed, these are a few other things that we should deal with. First of all, if any of you have not filled out the questionnaire with picket duty choices on it, a new re-revised questionnaire is available at the doors and at the front here. Please pick one up, fill it in, and return it quickly.

by Wed am to U.O Pass it to people in your office. Also, please keep your pay stub for this month (Apr. 30). It will be used for pay raise. You will be asked to present onto p 2.

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As far as strategy is concerned, it is up to the S.C. to make the decisions on where to picket. We will report back to the membership on pertinent info eg. cost - once a strategy is employed. The membership can then decide whether to continue. If you have not been contacted & go to work only to find pickets around your building, contact the U.S. immediately.

We may decide to picket only one office in a building; if that is the case, you will not be asked to picket your office - you will be assigned to another building.
