Dear Sisters and Brothers,

For more than 25 weeks, the National Union of Miners (NUM) has been conducting a national strike against mine closings in Britain. These closings threaten not only tens of thousands of jobs but whole communities as well. International solidarity is desperately needed as Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher's Conservative government is bent on starving these workers back to the mines and breaking their union. To organize support, the National Union of Miners has issued an international appeal for financial aid and solidarity to which the Canadian Labour Congress has already donated \$17,000.

To organize support for this appeal, Steve Shukla, a 25 year old miner and member of the Armthrope Branch of the NUM, is touring North America. Shukla will be in Vancouver October 12-16. Shukla has already toured the United States and the response hac been very enthusiastic. Steve has spoken to workers at union meetings of the United Auto Workers in St. Louis, the United Mine Workers of America in southern Illinois and the United Steel Workers of America in Missouri, to name a few. All have contributed what they could in solidarity with the strike.
