RE: POSSIBLE NURSES STRIKE AND

CUPE National Rep

Rosanne gave report on Tuesday meeting with the employer:

39/202 requested for essential services. Nothing in writing. Wednesday received proposal in writing. Later contacted by Arne Johannson requesting our decision by 5:00 although a meeting had already been set for Friday. Employer had in the meantime gone to IRC for assistance (we are boycotting IRC & in our absence we would probably not get a Thursday, May 18, our fair hearing. representatives met with Eileen Stewart who said she had been totally misinformed. Joe suggested a private mediator. Thursday, May 18 at 3:00 we were advised this would be employer accepted agreeable and our suggestion of Stephen Kelleher. Booked of S.Kelleher for today between 1:00 - 5:00 p.m. and he is available Sunday.

The two parties would split expenses and CUPE would pay 50% of our expenses. If legal assistance is required and CUPE cannot supply, they will pay 50% of legal expenses.

Hospital service chiefs met yesterday and concluded - negotiation meeting planned for Tuesday, May 23rd. They anticipate a breakdown of talks but don't feel the nurses will picket at that time. S. Claybo, D. Field, and S. Lundy will stay to contact members who have been designated essential.

We will advise inquiries that we are discussing essential services with the employer, we don't expect a picket line on Tuesday, May 23rd, but if there is one DON'T CROSS IT!
