The results of the June 21, 1982 referendum on secession from the Association of University and College Employees was as follows:

Less than 50% plus one of the membership at AUCE Local Five voted in favour of seceeding from AUCE. According to Section 6A of the Provincial Constitution:

"The vote shall be by secret ballot. <u>A majority of the Local Association</u> <u>Membership</u> shall approve the motion for secession before it will be considered passed."

Because the referendum on secession was not approved by the required 50% plus one of the Local membership the referendum failed.

After tabulating the results of the referendum, the Provincial Executive passed the following motion:

"That the Provincial Executive will not oppose the PPWC application for certification of AUCE Local Five."

On behalf of the Provincial Executive, I offer our best wishes to your Local. Although we hope that you will decide to remain within AUCE, you can count on our support regardless of what you decide. We look forward to being able to work with your local on issues of common support in the future.
