There are a couple of problems brought to our attention by staff in the Computing Centre, that I would appreciate your looking into.

The first concerns parking stickers. AUCE members, working on afternoon and night shifts have had great difficulty in obtaining preferred parking stickers. Usually, each year, after considerable wrangling and a group of people going together to the Traffic Office, these stickers are issued. Is there no way that a memorandum could be provided to these people and the Traffic Office so that preferred parking stickers can be provided for those people working on these shifts? We are of course concerned about long distances having to be walked in order to get to and go home from the Computing Centre.

The second area of concern is the lighting around the back of the Computing Centre. We would appreciate Physical Plant having a look at the area and making some recommendations to improve lighting both on the street and at the back of the building.
