- 2 That immediately afterwards notice of claim for  
rent was put in on the Premises, wherein we had  
seized and lodged the goods and effects on the

- 3 In consequence of the insecure state of the Premises  
and of the pressure by parties having claims on

in consequence of our being obliged to keep or pay for  
such possession and care and Rent is still and  
continues to grow and accrue and other expenses  
are incurred which would be obviated by the  
removal and early sale of the said goods and



Effects and we deem and believe it to  
be advisable that a sale should forthwith  
be effected by auction of the same.
