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GENEOLOGICAL CHART OF THE ROSSETTI FAMILY




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## COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

### **Angeli, Helen Rossetti, collector**

Angeli-Dennis collection

ca.1803-1964

4 m of textual records

Helen Rossetti Angeli and Imogene Dennis maintained a collection of records of the Rossetti family and of other noted artists. William Michael Rossetti (1829-1919) was a pre-Raphaelite writer and an art critic. He also edited the works of his brother, Dante Gabriel Rossetti (1828-1882), and of his sister, Christina Rossetti (1830-1894). William Michael Rossetti also held duties as a civil servant with the Excise Branch of the British government.

The Angeli-Dennis collection contains the diaries (1855-1913), manuscripts, financial records and correspondence of William Michael Rossetti. Also included are the manuscripts, correspondence and financial records of Dante Gabriel Rossetti (1842-1882), Christina Georgina Rossetti (1853-1894), Ford Madox Brown (1852-1993), Gabriele Rossetti and other members of the Rossetti family. In addition, the collection includes materials of Robert Browning, Thomas Landseer, William North, Algernon Swinburne and James Thomson.

The Angeli-Dennis papers came to the University through two separate acquisitions from the former home of Helen Rossetti Angeli at Woodstock, England. Dr. William E. Fredeman acquired the papers on behalf of the University. The first acquisition in 1966 consisted primarily of papers of William Michael Rossetti. The second acquisition in 1972 resulted in further Rossetti family papers from Imogene Dennis, Helen Rossetti Angeli's daughter. The collection was handled by researchers interested in the Pre-Raphaelites prior to the papers' deposit in the UBC library. No doubt the provenance of the manuscripts was disturbed. Upon their arrival some of the papers were arbitrarily interfiled on various subjects such as D.G. Rossetti's state of health and his work, Poems, 1870. Also, letters to William Michael Rossetti were re-arranged from their chronological order to an alphabetical one by a researcher. Rather than attempting to reconstruct the papers to their original order, the papers were arranged into groups of Rossetti family members and non-Rossetti family members. For example, the letters of Robert Browning and A.C. Swinburne were not returned to Rossetti family groups to become incoming letters of Dante Gabriel Rossetti, William Michael Rossetti, etc. A manuscript by William North which was found in the papers, but seemed to have no relationship to the family papers, was arranged under a separate group, the William North papers. The same procedure was followed with the papers of other non-family members.

## SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

1. William Michael Rossetti. – 1855-1917. – 1.5 m.  
Series consists of the papers of William Michael Rossetti, (1829-1919) and includes diaries, manuscripts, financial records, subject files, letters, miscellany, and printed material. Series material reflects his activities as a Pre-Raphaelite, a writer, an art critic, an editor of the literary works of his brother, Dante Gabriel Rossetti, and his sister Christina Rossetti, and as the general guardian of the Rossetti family's artistic reputation.
2. Christina Georgina Rossetti. – 1848-1894. – 15 cm.  
Series consists of the papers of Christina Rossetti, (1830-1894), and includes manuscripts, letters, financial records, interviews, memorabilia, and printed material. Series reflects her activities as a writer and as a member of the Rossetti family, and her connection with the Pre-Raphaelite circle.
3. Gabriele Charles Dante Rossetti. – 1843-1882 – 62 cm.  
Series consists of the papers of Dante Gabriel Rossetti, (1828-1882), and includes manuscripts, letters, notes, subject files, documents, printed material and miscellany. Series reflects his activities as a Pre-Raphaelite, a poet, a painter, and a member of the Rossetti family.
4. Maria Francesca Rossetti. – 1837-1876 – 2 cm  
Series consists of the papers of Maria Francesca Rossetti, (1827-1876), and includes manuscripts, letters, other documents and miscellany. Series reflects her activities as a writer and as a member of the Rossetti family.
5. Frances Mary Lavinia Rossetti. – 1816-1886. – 8 cm  
Series consists of the papers of Frances Mary Lavinia (Polidori) Rossetti, (1801-1886), and includes diaries, manuscripts and letters. Series reflects her activities as a member of the Rossetti family, including her brief attempt at running a day school.
6. Lucy Madox Rossetti. – [ca.1866]-1894 – 18 cm  
Series consists of the papers of Lucy Madox (Brown) Rossetti, (1843-1894), and includes letters, notes, and documents. Series reflects her activities as a member of the Rossetti family through her marriage to William Michael Rossetti.
7. Antonio Rossetti. – 1898-1907. – 0.5cm.  
Series consists of letters.

8. Isabella Pietrocola (Cole) Rossetti. – 1883-1910. – 0.5 cm.  
Series consists of letters.
9. Mary Rossetti. – 1867-1912. – 1 cm.  
Series consists of incoming and outgoing letters of Mary Rossetti. Series reflects her activities as a member of the Rossetti family through her parents Lucy Madox and William Michael Rossetti.
10. Olivia Agresti. – 1897-1952. – 2 cm.  
Series consists of incoming and outgoing letters of Olivia (Rossetti) Agresti. Series reflects her activities as a member of the Rossetti family through her parents Lucy Madox and William Michael Rossetti
11. Teodorico Pietrocola Rossetti. – 1853-1882. – 1 cm.  
Series consists of outgoing letters.
12. Helen Angeli. – 1885-1964. – 6 cm  
Series consists of the papers of Helen (Rossetti) Angeli, and includes manuscripts and letters. Series reflects her activities as a member of the Rossetti family through her parents Lucy Madox and William Michael Rossetti.
13. Charlotte Polidori. – 1862-1885. – 0.5 cm  
Series consists of incoming and outgoing letters of Charlotte Polidori. Series reflects her activities as a member of the Rossetti family as sister to Frances Maria Lavinia Rossetti.
14. Elizabeth Eleanor Siddal. – 1861. – 0.1 cm.  
Series consists of one letter to Mrs. Ford Madox Brown. Siddal, (1829-1862), was connected to the Rossetti family through her marriage to Dante Gabriel Rossetti.
15. Elizabeth Brown. – [ca.184-?]. – 1 cm.  
Series consists of manuscripts of Elizabeth Brown, first wife of Ford Madox Brown.
16. Ford Madox Brown. – 1852-1893. – 12 cm.  
Series consists of the papers of Ford Madox Brown, (1821-1893), and includes letters, financial records, and printed material. Series reflects his activities as a person close to the Rossetti family and to the Pre-Raphaelite circle.
17. Oliver Madox Brown. – 1855-1874. – 2 cm  
Series consists of the papers of Oliver Madox Brown, brother of Lucy Madox Rossetti, and includes manuscripts, letters, and miscellany.

18. Robert Browning. – 1858-1889. – 0.5 cm  
Series consists of outgoing letters. Browning, (1812-1889), was a friend of Dante Gabriel Rossetti.
19. Thomas Landseer. – 1858-1860. – 0.5 cm  
Series consists of letters.
20. William North. – n.d., 0.5 cm  
Series consists of one item, a poem.
21. Frederic Shields. – [ca.1891-ca.1905]. – 0.5 cm  
Series consists of letters of Frederic Shields. Shields (1833-1911), studied painting under Dante Gabriel Rossetti, thus connecting him to the Pre-Raphaelite circle.
22. Frederic George Stephens. – 1844-1907. – 12 cm.  
Series consists of letters and subject files of Frederic George Stephens (1828-1907). Series reflects his activities as an artist-turned-art critic and a later member of the Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood.
23. Algernon Charles Swinburne. – 2 cm.  
Series consists of manuscripts and letters of A.C. Swinburne (1837-1909). Series reflects his activities as a poet and as a friend of Dante Gabriel Rossetti and the Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood.
24. James Thomson. – [ca.1870-ca.1890]. – 1 cm  
Series consists of manuscripts and letters of poet James Thomson (1834-1882), friend of William Michael Rossetti.
25. People Outside the Rossetti Circle. – 1882-1909. – 3 cm.  
Series consists of material from people who are not members of the Rossetti family, nor are they connected to it through marriage. Series consists of manuscripts, letters, and printed material.
26. Gabriele Rossetti. – [ca.1812-ca.1860]. – 20 cm  
Series consists of the papers of Gabriele Rossetti, (1783-1854), and includes letters, manuscripts, and related material. Series reflects his life as an Italian poet, critic, and exile and as a member of the Rossetti family.
27. Eliza Polidori. – [a.1853-ca.1855]. – 1 cm  
Series consists of outgoing letters of Eliza Polidori, sister of Frances Mary Lavinia Rossetti.
28. Gaetano Polidori. – [a.1803-ca.1860]. - 12 cm  
Series consists of letters of Gaetano Polidori,(1765-1859). Polidori was father of Frances Mary Lavinia Rossetti, thus connecting him to the Rossetti family.

29. Cajetan Polidori. – n.d., 8 cm.  
Series consists of a manuscript.
30. John Polidori. – [1816?] – 24 cm.  
Series consists of letters and extracts from a journal.
31. Covers. – 12 cm  
Series consists of packets in which contents of the Angeli-Dennis collection were kept.

Correspondents to W.M. Rossetti were Oliver Elton, Anne Gilchrist, Sudakichi Hartman, James Houston, J.H. Johnston, J.B. Marvin, Charles Rowley, and Horace Traubel. Gilchrist also corresponded with Lucy M. Rossetti.

#### Letters

The William M. Rossetti letters were rearranged from their original state, in chronological order, to arrangement by author prior to this inventory. W.M. Rossetti's original order was probably similar to that which he stated on a packet of papers of Gaetano Polidori, "In this and other packets I follow the same order of arrangement as appears more distinctly in the Packets for D.G. Rossetti – beginning with writings and his own mss. and ending with letters addressed to him."
