According to the Canadian Customs Tariff all goods which are to be entitled to the British Preferential Tariff must contain 50% British content, with the exception of a few articles.

I should appreciate it if you would kindly inform me whether 50% British content means that 50% of the value of such an article must result only from labor in one or more British countries, or whether the 50% must constitute British material and labor.
