It may interest you to know that I have been successful in having the Department of National Revenue, Canada, change the tariff classification on these articles from Tariff Item 326 to Tariff Item 326a, thereby reducing the rate of duty on importations from Germany to 20-10% from 30%.

It is my intention to communicate this information to German manufacturers of ampoules in order that they may inform their customers in Canada of the proper tariff classification.
