Scope and content: Fonds consists of materials created and accumulated by Heroldine Copp in relation to her long involvement with the Vancouver-Burrard Liberal Association. The materials also relate to numerous other Liberal Party organisations, including the British Columbia Liberal Advisory Council, the Young Liberal Association of British Columbia, and the National Federation of Liberal Women of Canada. Fonds includes agendas, correspondence, case notes, minutes, newsletters, reports.

Biographical information:

Heroldine M. Copp began her long active involvement with the Liberal Party in 1931. In British Columbia she was active in the Vancouver-Burrard Liberal Association and other provincial Liberal organisations. She held numerous positions, including the chair of various committees and the position of President 1959-1962. She was also involved in the federal Liberal Party, and was appointed to the National Policy Committee in 1961. Between 1945 and 1948 she was the Vice-President then President of the Vancouver Board of Trade. In the late 1960s she left Vancouver to reside in the Kootenays.
