Re: Washroom Facilities - Housing Department, UBC

It has come to my attention that the washroom facilities for the staff in the Housing Department, located in the Ponderosa Building at the University of British Columbia, are inadequate. The staff of approximately 23 employees are currently sharing washroom facilities with the general public

It appears to me that this would be in contravention of Department of Labour regulations as it cannot be guaranteed that the minimum requirements for washroom facilities can be maintained when the washroom facilities of staff are shared with the general public. The general public in this case consists of students using the one-half of the Ponderosa building which is a student cafeteria.

On behalf of the staff currently working in the Housing Department I request that you appoint an inspector to investigate the premises as soon as possible.
