

It is our understanding that the following wording contained in the petitions that you signed, composed and circulated presents the Union with difficulties: "We the undersigned, therefore do not give you permission to deduct any monies from our pay cheques for union purposes other than for monthly dues."

The above wording revoking the right to be assessed for other than monthly dues appears to be all-inclusive in nature in that it stretches indefinitely into the future to cover any possible assessments.

We would suggest that you contact Employee Relations and revoke your "original revocation" so that you may be deducted any future assessments, such as the \$5.00 Strike Fund assessment due to come off our paycheques at the end of August.

It may be that the University considered your original revoking of the right to be assessed as only applying to the June 30th \$50.00 assessment. But, to avoid any further possible complications, the Executive would recommend that you contact the University and reinstate the regular assessment deduction process.
