Introduction

This collection consists of notes and materials gathered by Mr. Hayward in connection with two research projects: first, a study of the organization and aims of the UFAWU, 1977-78, including notes from his attendance at union meetings; secondly, the "Fish and Ships" Project, 1981-84, with records of his participation, notes, interviews, and drafts of chapters produced toward the publication a book. Included also are several articles written by Mr. Hayward, and his 1981 M.A. thesis.

Mr. Hayward was a Social Science Researcher with the "Fish and Ships" Project from its beginning in July 1981, and was involved in planning stages as early as 1979. The group was engaged in study of the fisheries industry, fisheries and fish processing labour force, and fishing communities on the B.C. coast, in the overall context of a study of capital and markets.
