## BRUNSWICK CANNERY

The Brunswick Canning Company constructed three Brunswick Canneries; two on the Fraser River in 1893 and the third at Rivers Inlet. They were so named to commemorate the early association of the owners of the company with New Brunswick. In 1903 the canneries were sold to the British Columbia Packer's Association. At that time the operations of Brunswick #1 at Steveston were amalgamated with the adjoining Imperial Cannery while the Rivers Inlet cannery remained operational until 1930. The Brunswick Cannery at Canoe Pass canned salmon until 1930 when it became a fish camp for Imperial.

The records were generated by the Brunswick Cannery located at Canoe Pass (1900-1928). The bulk of the material consists of financial records; most notably invoices and receipts from various merchants in the area. These records provide some useful information about the types of goods and services that were required by the early canneries and also indicate the cost of such items. The collection also includes some material from the Anglo-American Cannery Company (1896-1913).
