Introduction

The acquisition came to the Special Collections Division in two definite blocks of material encompassing two political sub-groups - The League for Socialist Action and the Young Socialists. Within each grouping there were important sub-groups which were kept as such.

The League for Socialist Action (LSA) covers Pts. I-VI in the table of contents. Part I deals with the minutes etc. of the organization itself whereas Part II has been maintained as a definite group since it deals solely with the Vietnam War. Although the Vietnam Action Committee (VAC) is structured as a separate entity it is an offshoot of the LSA. For this reason it follows directly behind the LSA material.

Part III-IV covers two important elements in the left wing spectrum of politics- The Unions and the Young New Democrats/New Democrat Party. These two blocks of material arrived separately and have been maintained separate from the research files.

Part V is the LSA Library and deals with materials which are directly associated with the political leanings of the party. Part VI contains the research files of the party and these cover a wide range of topics and subjects.

, The Young Socialist material begins with Part VII and contains much the same type of material as the LSA but it concentrates more on the aspects of campus and political education than the LSA material.

The Socialist Workers Party (SWP) has its Research Files in Part VIII, although this is not as clear a delineation as in the above groups. Part IX covers material which could not be directly associated with any of the groups but could in fact be part of any of them. The scrapbooks have a personal touch and probably are the personal keepsakes of the Bullock family. The slides used for The Vietnam Action Committee are to be found in Box 18 and there has been no inventory done on them.

In Box 19 there is printed material relating to the United Fishermen and Allied Workers' Union (UFAWU). This material is unsorted.
