- 1. Copies of 14 heraldic crests of "Norfolk families"
- 2. 2 folio leaves (1 full sheet) with 16 basic crest designs per page (16 roughly drawn)
- 3. A list of the various crests for the names Pagrand, Palgrand
- 4. 3 leaves of genealogies for Norfolk, Suffolk "extracted out of McCornwall's Book". Last leaf dated 22 July 1698 and finis J. B.
- 5. 5 leaves pinned at top and numbered 240-248 on various genealogies
- 6. "Arms of the Nobility and Gentry in Norfolk and Suffolk", 6 leaves. Alphabetically, A to Z
- 7. Bulwer genealogy? (partial)
- 8. Genealogy of John Cork family of Herford and Norfolk.
- 9. Genealogy of names from Balam to Bekham
- 10. Copy of list of names of families whose pedigrees were done, 1603
