INTRODUCTION

In 1956 when the C.L.C. was established, regional education offices were created. The function of these offices was to provide instruction for union members and their representatives in a variety of labour related areas. These areas included shop, steward training, parliamentary procedure, public speaking, collective bargaining, labour history and technological change.
