Introduction

This inventory describes the records of the Fisheries Association of British Columbia (FABC), contained in 69 boxes, extending 19.5 metres. They include correspondence, minutes, and reference materials relating to government relations, health and safety regulations, international treaties and commissions, labour negotiations and agreements, and general public relations. There are records of the association as well as its predecessor, the Salmon Canners Operating Committee, covering the years 1938 to 1976. The bulk of the records date from 1955 to 1975. The records were transferred from the offices of the Fisheries Council of B.C. to the University of B.C.'s Special Collections in two accessions, the first on June 1986, and the second in March 1988.

Boxes 7, 13, and 36 (of the first accession) are restricted until July 1, 1996. They contain member assessments and other internal financial records of the FABC.

Administrative History

The Fisheries Association of British Columbia, with headquarters in Vancouver, existed between 1951 and 1984 as the official representative body of the fish processing companies on the west coast of Canada. The FABC was the legitimate successor of the various cannery associations and the fish processor associations that had existed in B.C. since 1892. In 1924 an arrangement was made with the Canadian Manufacturers Association to have that body represent the fish processors of the province. This changed the name of the group from the British Columbia Canners Association to the Canadian Manufacturers Association.

Early in 1939, the canners severed their connection with the Canadian Manufacturers Association and formed the Salmon Canners Operating Committee. The canners group continued under this name until 1951 when the Fisheries Association of B.C. was established as the western division of the Fisheries Council of Canada (FCC). Its membership, in addition to salmon canners, represented all forms of fish processing in the province.

The Fisheries Association of B.C. promoted the interests of the fishing industry by acting as a liaison and lobby group with the Federal, provincial and municipal governments, as well as conducting general public relations activities for the industry. Its concerns included resource and spawning streams protection, government safety and health regulations, and industry representation on international treaties and fisheries commissions. The Fisheries Association also acted as the industry bargaining agent for negotiations over fish prices and wages with fishermen and shoreworkers unions and associations. The association was organized with a general council with numerous committees reporting on sales and advertising, labour matters and general operating matters.

Walter Payson was secretary to the Salmon Canners Operating Committee from 1939 to 1942 when he was replaced by John MacDonald who continued as the first secretary of the FABC until 1960. He was followed by Kenneth Campbell from 1961 to 1972. Mr. Campbell left to become president of the Fisheries Council of Canada and was replaced at the FABC by Mr. J. Spitz. He was succeeded by Mr. G. Jones in 1981 who was secretary in 1984 when the FABC severed its connection with the FCC.

The disassociation, on November 1, 1984 was intended to give the west coast fishing industry more autonomy over issues pertaining specifically to the pacific region. The functions of the FABC were split into two parts with the Fish Processors Bargaining Association (FPBA) handling negotiations with the United Fishers and Allied Workers Union and the Native Brotherhood regarding wages and fish prices. All other functions of a trade association and promotion agency were transferred to the Fisheries Council of British Columbia. Mr. Mike Hunter was the first president of the Council.

Scope and Content Note

The records of the Fisheries Association of British Columbia were transferred to the University Archives in two separate accessions. The first, consisting of 56 boxes was officially transferred to Special Collections in June 1986. The remaining 13 boxes were removed to the University in March 1988. The records cover the years from 1938 to 1976 with the bulk of them in the period from 1955 to 1975. Some of the series span the years and the change of name from the Salmon Canners' Operating Committee to the FABC in 1951. A smaller group of records from the SCOC were not integrated into the filing system and are treated separately within the inventory.

The office record keeping system for these records, which is also their current system, partly involves different alphabetic series which are related to the different functions of the FABC. One main exception to this pattern is the Negotiations and Agreements of the Labour Series. These records are filed chronologically. Some of the other series described in this inventory do not appear to have any particular order to them since the series or sub-series is relatively small.

When the records were boxed for transfer little care was taken to maintain their original order. In some cases, fragments of series were intermingled with other series and the alphabetic arrangement was reversed in the boxes. The numbers assigned to the boxes in no way reflect the actual order of some of the multi-box series. The order of the records was also changed when a history student prepared a file list in 1985 for the first accession (prior to their official transfer). indicated by her file list in the appendix, certain files were moved from one box to another. Unfortunately, no justification for these moves has been recorded. The original order of the series has been reconstructed to the best of our abilities. While the files themselves do have colour coded labels which appear to be date related, the coding does not seem to have been strictly adhered to and was of no assistance in reconstructing original order.

Most of the description of the records in this inventory is at the series or sub-series level, and file lists are included especially where a subject alphabetic arrangement exists to make the records accessible. An appendix of the complete file list is attached to indicate the exact location of the files, especially for those belonging to a series which has been disturbed.

Boxes 7, 13, and 36 from the first accession have been restricted until July 1, 1996 due to the financial nature of some of the files. Some of the files in these boxes, however, appear to have been inadvertently restricted due to their box location and not the actual content of the files. A future examination of the nature of the restrictions as they apply to such files may make them available earlier.

Because of the two accessions, the boxes are numbered in two separate sequences. As well, the first accession contains several unnumbered boxes. To keep the locations relatively clear in the inventory the following conventions have been used: a simple box number (for example - Box 23) indicates a box in the first accession, the unnumbered boxes of the first accession have been given an alphabetic designation (UN-C), and the second accession boxes are indicated as 2Acc- and a number (2Acc-9). Clearly the boxes need to be renumbered as one sequence to prevent confusion.

A4 Labour Relations Series, 1946-1974.

Consisting of files concerning the FABC's function of acting as the industry bargaining agent for negotiations over fish prices, wages and benefits, and files concerning other employment and union related records.

A4.1 Negotiations and Agreements. 1938-1974.

Negotiations and agreements are for the most part filed together in a chronological order. Thus, records concerning any negotiations and agreements with the Tendermen's Union, for example, are not found together, but separated from each other by other files created in the same set of years. The signed agreements found in Boxes 54 and 55, however, have been separated from the accompanying agreements.

A4.2 North Coast. 1947-1969.

Box 9. - 32.0 cm.

Consisting of labour records dealing with the North Coast area of British Columbia and the Native Brotherhood, the native union which corresponds to the United Fishers and Allied Workers Union which is primarily Caucasian. Since the Native Brotherhood was originally the main union working the northern coast, their files are included in this subseries. Note, however, that any Native Brotherhood Negotiations and Agreements are found in that part of the Labour Series (A4.1).

A4.3 Alphabetic Labour Subjects.

There are two separate alphabetic subseries which deal with the labour functions of the FABC. The primary distinguishing factor between the two is that one is part of the first accession and the other is from the second accession. Both deal with the same general type of subjects, but they have been kept separate for the inventory since they were separate in the office. Since the files from the first accession have been disarranged, the following list recreates the original alphabetic order. The files for the second subseries can be found in the appendix and start at Annual Holdings in Box 2Acc-13, run through 2Acc-5, and end at Workers' Compensation in 2Acc-6.

A5 Fishing Development and Protection. 1939-1974.

Consisting of records which pertain to the development of the industry, including markets, and the protection of fishing grounds, spawning areas and the fish themselves. The series further breaks down into four subseries: polution, resouce, rivers, and licence limitations.

A5.1 Pollution. 1939-1974.

Boxes 10,31. - 64.0 cm.

Includes files labelled pollution or dealig with the pollution of waterways. Subject matters dealt with include pulp and forest product inquiry, Canadian Environmental Council, and waste water.

A5.2 Resource. 1939-1974.

This subseries consists of two groups of files, each organized as separate alphabetic lists. In the first, the order has been disturbed with files scattered throughout a number of boxes. The second, with subjects form Anchovy to Zooplankton, is better organized in three consecutive boxes. The subjects covered in both groups are extremely varied and the reasons for separating them into two alphabetic lists could not be determined (the dates of the two sets of files overlap). All of the files in both groups are concerned, in general, with the issue of the development and protection of the resource and span issues from marine ecology to economics.

A5.3 Waterways. 1939-1974.

This subseries consists of files arranged alphabetically which have been separated throughout four boxes. All of the files concern, and are titled with, spawning waterways on the north Pacific coast, extending alphabetically from Adams River to Yukon and Taku Rivers.

APPENDIX

LIST OF CANNERY ASSOCIATIONS

- Before 1892 Some time before 1892 the processors organized The Canners Association.
 This disbanded about 1894.
- September 1897 The Salmon Canners formed The Combination of Cannery Packers, generally known as the "Cannery Association". This continued until close of the canning season of 1899.
- Fall of 1899 The Cannery Association amended its constitution to include processors from all Provincial areas, and changed its name to British Columbia Salmon Packers Association. In 1902 this merged with the Fraser River Canners Association.
- 1900 The Fraser River Canners formed their own association (as distinct from the British Columbia Salmon Packers Association) naming it the Fraser River Canners Association.
- 1902 Fraser River Canners Association and British Columbia Salmon Packers Association united, and decided to be known as Fraser River Canners Association, although it included practically all salmon canning operators in British Columbia. The name was changed in 1909.
- 1909 The name of this organization was changed to British Columbia Canners Association, as being more representative of the group. This continued until 1924, when the canners group was enlarged to take in other processors.
- 1924 In 1924 an arrangement was made with the Canadian Manufacturers Association to have that body represent the fish processors of the Province. The name of the fisheries group then was changed to Canned Salmon Section and Fish Meal and Oil, and Dry Salt Section of the Canadian Manufacturers Association. This arrangement ended about the beginning of 1939.
- 1939 Early in 1939 the canners severed their connection with the Canadian Manufacturers Association and formed The Salmon Canners Operating Committee. The canners group continued under this name until 1951.
- 1951 Fisheries Association of B.C. was organized in 1951, replacing The Salmon Canners Operating Committee. Its membership, in addition to salmon canners, comprises those engaged in all forms of fish processing in the Province.

ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

The Fisheries Council of British Columbia (FCBC) existed from 1984 to 1998 and was a trade association which represented the interests of the fish processing companies in the province. Although membership fluctuated due the changing nature of the industry there were a number of members which remained constant. These included Bella Coola Fisheries, British Columbia Packers, Canadian Fishing Company, Lion's Gate Fisheries, Nelson Bros. Fisheries, J.S. McMillan Fisheries, and Ocean Fisheries and together these companies were responsible for the employment of the majority of the workers in the industry. Companies such as these were designated as Full Council members. The Council also bestowed Affiliate Member status on companies within the smoked salmon industry and upon companies which supplied products and services to the fish processing sector. The FCBC conducted its affairs through various committees which were chaired by representatives of the member companies. For the duration of its existence Mike Hunter was the president of the FCBC.

The Fisheries Council of British Columbia was actively involved in various issues pertaining to the West Coast fishery. The FCBC participated in numerous Federal and Provincial Government initiatives such as workshops and meetings which were related to issues of the Pacific fishery. The FCBC was also concerned with issues such as the Native fishery and the promotion of Pacific fishery market goods.

From 1951 to 1984 the FCBC was known as the Fisheries Association of British Columbia (FABC) and was a member of the nation-wide Fisheries Council of Canada (FCC). In 1984, the FABC withdrew from the FCC in order to concentrate on West Coast fishery concerns and to be an independent voice for the Pacific region. With the formation of the FCBC the functions of the FABC were divided. The Fish Processors Bargaining Association handled negotiations with the United Fishers and Allied Workers Union and the Native Brotherhood regarding wages and fish prices. The functions of a trade association and a promotion agency were transferred to the FCBC.

It is unclear what happened to the FCBC, but it appears that the organization ceased to exist after April of 1998 due to the collapse of the British Columbia fishing industry.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

The fonds consists of the records generated by the FCBC and by its predecessor body, the FABC. The records relate to the functions of the FCBC in its pursuance of matters related to the West Coast fishing industry. The records consist of and relate to the participation of the FCBC in various Federal and Provincial meetings, issues related to the Native Fishery, matters pertinent to the West Coast industry, and minutes of the various committees through which the FCBC conducted its affairs. The records have been arranged into the following series: I. Internal Affairs, 1984-1998; II. External Affairs, 1979-1997; III. Participation in Federal and Provincial Meetings, 1974-1995; IV. Aboriginal Affairs, 1986-1995; V. Library Resources, 1966-1989; VI. Labour Agreements, 1964-1988.
