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INTRODUCTION

Harold Thayer, born in 1918, joined the CCF in 1938 and the International Association of Machinists, Lodge 741, St. James, Manitoba, 1941, and has been active in both organizations until his retirement in 1984. He has been a member of the IAM Lodge 456, Victoria, 1942-52, Lodge 692, Vancouver, from 1952; Education and Public Relations Director for Canada, IAM, 1961- 1970's, editor of the Canadian edition of the Machinist, 1968- 1970's, and director of the Canadian Machinist Political League, 1967- 1970's. He has served as President, Lodge 456, 1947-51, and Lodge 692, 1959-61, and Vice-President for the Ontario Federation of Labour in the 1960's. His political commitment toward the CCF and NDP included the positions of Secretary, Victoria Oak Bay CCF Association, 1944-49, Provincial Secretary-Treasurer for B.C. CCF, 1952-61, editor, B.C. CCF News, 1952-61, Executive Secretary, B.C. New Party founding committee, 1959-61, and a member of the NDP Federal Council, Federal Executive, and Federal Election Planning Committee, 1970's.

The papers have been divided into various subgroups. In addition to his personal material, there are subgroups entitled International Association of Machinists, B.C. Federation of Labour, Canadian Labour of Congress, Ontario Federation of Labour, the Co-Operative Commonwealth Federation (Federal and B.C.-Yukon) and the New Democratic Party (Federal, B.C., Ontario). The papers are organized largely chronologically backwards, as this was how the correspondence was filed. Harold Thayer often grouped together correspondence and notes about a particular subject. This grouping has been retained and the group has been filed as incoming or outgoing by the date and type of the top letter.
