This collection of papers is the product of Harold Madison Wright's involvement in the Olympic Movement, the Canadian Field Hockey Association and both the Canadian and International Mining Industries. The purpose of this introduction is to briefly describe these particular efforts as well as other significant undertakings and achievements in Mr. Wright's career. Wright devoted countless hours in his many years of volunteer work and was recognized accordingly for his enormous contribution to a wide assortment of communities. His efforts at the international level challenge the accomplishments of those documented in Canadian History.

Born in Winnipeg, December 10, 1908, Harold Wright attended public school in Regina and then went on to the University of Alberta and the University of Utah to complete his Bachelor of Science in Geological Engineering in 1932. He returned to the University of British Columbia for graduate work in geology, earning a Master of Arts in 1933. Wright returned again to the University of Utah for his Master of Science degree in metallurgy, which was conferred upon him in 1936.

Upon completing his education, Wright moved to Vancouver to pursue his career as a consulting engineer. In 1947 he established Wright Engineering, a mining and metallurgical engineering firm offering a complete spectrum of engineering services. The business grew out of Wright Brothers and Associates, a company started by his brother

and himself. The firm specialized in mine planning, mineral processing plants, marine terminals and docks, water supply and waste disposal projects. The company pursued the international mining industry, implementing projects in over thirty countries and establishing additional offices in Australia and Bermuda. In addition to the presidency of Wright Engineers Ltd., Wright held numerous offices and directorships throughout his career. He served as President of the Canadian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy (1970-71) and represented Canada as an Overseas Member of Council to the London based Institution of Mining and Metallurgy. Also of particular note, Wright was a director of Western Mines, a member of the Advisory Council to the Ministry of Industry, Trade and Commerce and was on the Board of the Canada Permanent Trust Company.

In addition to his broad career in the mining industry, Harold Wright was extensively involved in athletic organizations. He is connected to the Olympic Movement in a variety of roles. As an athlete, he competed as a sprinter for the University of Alberta, the University of British Columbia and the University of Utah track teams. He represented Canada in the 1932 Olympic Games in Los Angeles, reaching the semi-finals of both the 100 and 200 meter events.

As a businessman, Wright played a major role in Canada's successful bid for the 1976 Summer Games. After three years as a director of the Canadian Olympic

Association (COA) and Olympic House (1966-68), he took on the office of COA President, guiding the organization throughout the bid, preparation and implementation of the XXI Olympic Games in Montreal (1969-77). In addition, Wright acted as a director of the Comité Organisateur des Jeux Olympique (COJO), the City of Montreal's Olympic planning body. Wright is responsible for the formation of the funding body of the COA, the Olympic Trust of Canada and also helped establish the Olympic Club of Canada, which recognizes past Olympians.

Wright was also closely connected to the games through his role as a fan, remaining long supportive of Canadian athletes, including members of his own family. His sons, Lee and James Wright were members of the Canadian Men's Field Hockey Team. Both Lee and his wife Thelma, a member of the Canadian Track and Field Team, competed in the 1964 Games in Tokyo, Japan.

Harold Wright was actively involved in sports organizations outside of the Olympic circle. He served as a director of the Commonwealth Games Association of Canada from 1972-77 and has acted as a director of the British Columbia Sports Federation. In addition, Wright acted as President of the Canadian Field Hockey Association from 1965 to 1969.

In recognition of his enormous contributions, Harold Wright was made an Officer of the Order of Canada in July of 1977. The British Columbia Sports Hall of Fame recognized

his contribution to amateur sport in 1979, inducting him as a "builder". Wright received the Consolidated Gold Fields Ltd. Gold Medal of The Institution of Mining and Metallurgy in 1965, The Donald J. McPharland Memorial Medal for Outstanding Performance in the Minerals Industry and the H.T. Airey, Noranda Award for Outstanding Service in Developing and Promoting Canadian Mineral Processing in Canada and Abroad. Wright holds a life membership to the Canadian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy and an Honorary Fellowship in The Institution of Mining and Metallurgy.

These correspondance files have been catalogued in the form in which they were generated and serve to document the most notable career of Harold Madison Wright.
