The Howard White Personal Fonds consists of correspondence, subject files and manuscipts created, edited, or handled by Howard White in his capacity as a writer or publisher of Harbour Publishing Co.

#### **BIOGRPAHICAL INFORMATION**

Born in 1945, Howard White has spent much of his life on the Sunshine Coast of British Columbia and at Madeira Park, B.C. He is the founder and editor of the <u>Raincoast</u> <u>Chronicles</u> series of books on British Columbia coast history and culture. In 1991 he was awarded the Stephen Leacock Medal for Humour for <u>Writing In The Rain</u>. His other books include <u>Ghost in the Gears</u>, (poetry), <u>The Men There Were Then</u> (poetry), and <u>Patrick and the Backhoe</u>. In addition, he edited <u>Accidental Airline</u>, <u>Spilsbury's Coast</u>, and <u>Forgotten Villages of the B.C. Coast</u>, as well as writing Bill White's work history, <u>A Hard Man To Beat</u>.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT

The personal fonds consists mainly of his personal manuscripts and his activities relating to his work as publisher of Harbour Publishing Company. Much of his incoming and outgoing correspondence as well as subject files relate to books he has published or is planning to do so in the future. The manuscripts consist of those submitted for publishing or for his opinion prior to submission to another publisher.

Howard White separated the material into personal and Harbour Publishing Company fonds prior to donating them to the University of British Columbia Library. Although authors have their different manuscripts in both the corporate and personal fonds, no attempt was made to put them together.
