## John Wallace de Beque Farris, 1878-1970

An inventory of His Papers in the Library of the University of British Columbia Special Collections Division

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John Wallace de Beque Farris was born in Whites's Cove New Brunswick in December. 3rd.,1878 to Lauchlan P. Farris and Mary Louise Hay Farris. J. Wallace de B. Farris appears to have obtained his political skills quite naturally. His father, Lauchlan Farris had been a Minister of Agriculture in the New Brunswick Legislative and his grandfather, John Farris, had been member in the New Brunswick Legislature before Confederation and was the first member of Parliament for Oeens County, N.B. after Confederation.

Before entering college, J.W.de B. Farris attended the public school in Whites' Cove and St. Martinns Seminary. Up on competed enrolled at Acadia University in Wolfville, Nova Scotia Where he obtained his B.A. and following this, he recieved his LL.B. During his years in Pennsylvania he courted Evlyn Fenwick Kierstad of Windsor, Nova Scotia and they were married on August 5th, 1905. They had four children; Katherine Hay, Donald Fenwick, Ralph Kierstad and Lauchlan John. After moving to British Columbia, J.W. de B. Farris joined the Liberal Party.and was first elected to the British Columbia Legislature in 1916 and served as Attoney-General of that province from 1917 to 1922. He was appointed to the Senate in 1936 and served asCouncil before the Privy Council and Supreme Court of Canada in many important cases.

Farris served as the president of both the Canadian Bar Association and B.C. Law Society He also recieved honory degrees from University of British Columbia and Acadia University.

The Farris papers arrived at UBC's Special Collections Division divided into Misécellanfous files and "File from Ottawa." After sorting the two files, it was apparent that subject matters did not differ and as a result the correspondence and leagal files contain paper from both the misecellanious and Ottawa files.. The outgoing letters are sorted into chropological order and incoming corresponded is filed in alphabetical order. In many cases the file folders for many subject and le gal files were not labelled by Farris, the headings were formulated at the discretion of the sorter. Legal files are differenfiated from subjec files in that former us  $\Re \frac{1}{2} \sqrt{\frac{1}{2}}$  consist of court cases.


