LOCALS 1735 AND 1081 AND PILEDRIVERS' LOCAL 1549

The Northwest District Council of Carpenters was formed in 1971 from Locals of the Carpenters in Kitimat and Prince Rupert and one Local of the Piledrivers and Bridgemen. The actual organisation of the carpentry craft began in 1909 in Prince Rupert. It was in this year that Local 1735 was chartered by the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America.

The files are not complete to the original Charter date. Much of the material from Local 1735 and 1549 was destroyed by fire in the early 1980s. Amongst the items salvaged were the Carpenters' Minute and dues books dating to 1922 and Piledriver Minute books from the Local's formation in the mid 1940s.

The material from Kitimat Local 1081 is complete. This period begins with the Kitimat Alcan period in the first part of the 1950s.

After the formation of the District Council, a central Union office was established in Terrace to police the eastern part of the jurisdictional area. A transfer free zone was set up throughout the entire district that stretches from the Queen Charlotte Islands to Smithers and from Kemano to the Yukon border. As a consequence, information on the centres outside of Kitimat and Prince Rupert can be found in boxes from both offices.

The material from the District Council, the Terrace and Smithers sub-locals and various jobsites is interspersed throughout the files. This seeming confusion reflects the trend in the Union to the concentration of activities in two offices, Prince Rupert and Terrace. These qualifications aside, the material in Boxes A to F is from Prince Rupert and Boxes G to N contains the Kitimat/Terrace Files.

The final unmarked boxes contain the various Minutes and Dues books, a collection of Collective Agreements, Constitutions, Bylaws and other sundry materials. These are, for the most part, related to the Carpenters and Building Trades. Other miscellaneous booklets are included from various trade unions.

One section that has been included is the documentation on Kitimat from past Sheetmetal International Representative, Jack Laurence. While this file contains mostly information on Kitimat and Local 561, it also has more general analysis of the Sheet Metal trade in Western Canada in the early and mid 1950s.

Throughout the boxes, certain files are listed with an asterisk before the number. These are current files held in the Terrace Office. A more complete history of the Northwest Labour movement, "FRONTIER LABOUR", is available.
