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### INTRODUCTION

# RAYMOND HULL PAPERS

Raymond Hull was a well-known Vancouver writer who was not only a best-selling author but also a lecturer, journalist and playwriter. He was born in Shaftesbury, Devon in England in 1919 and emigrated to Canada in 1947. The son a primitive Methodist minister, Hull found his oratorical "sermonizing" style to be effective and apparent in his words. However, before becoming a full time writer, Hull did various other jobs such as a farmhand, a waiter, a creative writing teacher, a steward on the Yukon River Sternwheel Steamer Casca and a model for art classes.

Hull became more of a full-time writer through time and continued success and has written thirty plays for the stage and TV (some of which are in this addendum). Some of the better known plays are The Drunkard, Wedded to a Villain and Roast Pig. Despite, these numerous plays, Hull was also interested in writing books, especially "how-to" factual books and co-authored many books. The book, he is most remembered for is The Peter Principle which he co-wrote with Laurence Peter. Other books he has written: Writing for Money in Canada, Profitable Playwriting, The Art of Making Wine, Gastown's Gassy Jack, and How To Get What You A number of these books have in turn become lecture material for the courses he taught for community centres and for the Vancouver School Board. These courses, were practical and interesting in their content and form and were a source of help to many students. Much research and care went into each book or course as is characteristic of Hull. The initial material was purchased from him in 1975 and the addenda were donated.

Part of the papers of Addenda #3 consist of unpublished book material which Hull was serious in amassing. There are many "directional" notes and other small notes which make up the files as well as numerous clippings. Also included are scripts and research for various plays, poems and songs (he had intended to collect them in a book). Nonetheless, one of the most interesting parts of his addendum is the presence of his two scrapbooks and journal which draw an intimate portrait of the well-known writer. Addenda #3 was prepared by Linda Yan in 1988. When clippings are listed, the number of clippings does not refer to the number of pages, but the number of individual clippings.
