#### Biographical information

Renee Goldsmith Kasinsky was born in the United States and became a landed immigrant in Canada in 1969. Kasinsky has taught sociology in both Canada and the United States and has worked as a consultant for Operon Research Association in Vancouver.

#### Scope and Contents

The fonds consists of records relating to issues such as amnesty, selective service and Canadian aid groups for draft resistors. Included is correspondence from the Vancouver Committee to Aid American War Objectors (1968-1975), questionnaires, related information and analysis (1969/70), interview transcripts, clippings, notes and printed material. The material was created during the writing of Kasinsky's book entitled, *Refugees from Militarism: Draft-Age Americans in Canada*.
