Seaboard Lumber Sales Company Limited/Seaboard Shipping Company Limited, Records, 1935-1979

Seaboard Lumber Sales Company Limited is one of the largest exporters of lumber in the world. The consortium of member mills comprising Seaboard originally came together to sell British Columbia timber products on international markets in competition with MacMillan Export Company Limited.

The first Seaboard Company, Astexo, was founded in 1928 and in 1935, Seaboard Lumber Sales Company Limited was incorporated. John A. Humbird, of Victoria Lumber and Manufacturing, Chemainus, was President from 1935 until the end of 1946. Humbird's European trips, documented in his detailed journals, successfully secured and developed export markets for the Seaboard mills' British Columbia timber products.

The history of Seaboard is a vital part of the history of the lumber trade in British Columbia. The full story is published in <u>Wood and Water: The Story of Seaboard Lumber and Shipping</u> by E.G. Perrault, Vancouver: Douglas and McIntyre, c1985, 320 p.

Scope and Content Note

The Seaboard records include John A. Humbird's journals of his overseas trips on behalf of Seaboard, the research collection of seaboard historical material used in the writing of their history, and various corporate records. The material spans almost fifty years of company history, from the 1935 incorporation of Seaboard, until 1979.

The corporate records include financial records, pension files, Distribution Department files, reports, material on the company's overseas operations, newsletters, the research collection and miscellaneous corporate records as well as photographs.

The journals and albums of John A. Humbird, President 1935 - 1946, comprise a sub-group of the collection, as does the photograph album of R.H. Edgett.
