Fonds Description

Title: Shizuye Takashima Fonds.

Dates of Creation: [1960s?]

Physical Description: 1 folder of textual material.

Biographical Sketch: Shizuye Takashima was born in British Columbia in 1930. At age eleven Shizuye was sent with her family to the Japanese internment camp of New Denver in British Columbia's interior. Following the war Shizuye studied art at the Ontario College of Fine Arts. After graduation she painted and worked as an instructor at her alma mater. Her experience in internment camps was the subject of an award-winning autobiographical book *A Child in Prison Camp*.

Scope and Content: Fonds consists of an annotated draft manuscript for Takashima's 1971 book *a Child in Prison Camp*.
