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### INTRODUCTION

Stanley Cooperman was born on October 22, 1929, in New York City. He received his B.A. at New York University and his Ph.D. at the University of Indiana where he taught for a number of years. He was later to hold teaching positions at Tehran University, the University of Oregon, Hofstra University, and Simon Fraser University, where he was a professor of English from 1969-1976.

During his early university years he earned maney as a journalist and freelance writer, taking up the writing of poetry later in his career. After many years of extensive travel, he finally settled in North Vancouver with his wife, Jenifer. Together they had two children: a daughter, Galila-Yael, and a son, Amichai.

In the course of his teaching career he was awarded a great number of fellowships and grants including a Research Grant from Simon Fraser University in 1967 and two Canada Council Grants, one in 1967 and the other in 1975.

In his lifetime he published five books, four volumes of poetry and one critical work, <u>World War I and the American Novel</u>. His untimely suicide in 1976 occurred while his fifth volume of poetry, <u>Canadian Gothic and Other Poems</u>, was at the press. <u>Greco's Last Book</u>, a volume of Cooperman's poems selected by Fred Candelaria, was published by Intermedia Press in 1980 in memory of the poet.

Cooperman's papers were donated to the U.B.C. library by his wife, Jenifer Cooperman, in 1983. The poetry series is of particular interest since Cooperman wrote several drafts of each poem before settling on a final version. Although Cooperman is best known for his poetry, there are also a great number of essays and plays to be found in this collection as well as some tapes of the poet reading his work.
