HISTORY

The Stanley Park C.C.F. Club was chartered on December 21, 1935 by the Provincial Office of the Co-operative Commonwealth Federation. It operated a storefront meeting hall at 1343 Robson Street. Around 1962, it became the Stanley Park NDP Club. The club became inactive in 1965 and its assets were dispersed in 1969.

CUSTODIAL HISTORY

This fonds was given by Stan Brook, a former member of the Stanley Park NDP Club, to Jim McKenzie, secretary of the Boag Foundation. McKenzie donated it, with other material, to Special Collections on April 1, 1993.

SCOPE AND CONTENTS

The fonds contains the ledger books of the Club, 1957-1969; minutes of the C.C.F. Vancouver Centre District Council, 1945-1946; a membership file, ca. 1966; an undated historical sketch of the Club; and other collected materials.
