BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Susan Mayse, raised on Vancouver Island, has been a freelance reporter, a radio announcer, a television scriptwriter, and a freelance writer. In addition to articles in national newspapers and magazines, she has written two books, Merlin's Web and Ginger: The Life and Death of Ginger Goodwin.

SCOPE/CONTENTS

The fonds consists of subject files, photographs, and interviews gathered and created by Susan Mayse in researching her biography of Ginger Goodwin. The files and interviews included information on major union organizations such as the British Columbia Federation of Labour, One Big Union, Industrial Workers of the World, and the United Mine Workers of America; related events such as the Vancouver Island Coal Mining Strike; and persons associated with Ginger Goodwin.
