INTRODUCTION: ORGANIZATION OF THE COLLECTION

The materials in the Transportation Employees Canadian Union Collection were deposited with Special Collections in February 1984. The records were discovered in a warehouse, apparently abandoned. They were turned over to the C.A.I.M.A.W. office and subsequently entrusted to Special Collections by Mr. M. Houle. The circumstances of their careless disposal was reflected in the disorder of their organization. The papers arrived in a largely unorganized format, with a minimum of ordered files. This necessitated considerable artificial arrangement, and difficulties were particularly evident in the correspondence series. Due to time constraints, some of the correspondence remains unsorted at this writing. [See files 1-45, 1-46, 1-47; also the 'Organizing Information' Subject Files, 2-19 and 2-20, which were office files.] Inexperience on the part of the arranger explains the lack of subgroups which are apparent in scanning this initial inventory. The enormity of the ambitions of the TECU executive are evident in the diffuse materials which have survived. The organization history should explain some of the complexities encountered in determining the source of various materials and the relationships between them.

ORGANIZATION HISTORY

The roots of the Transportation Employees Canadian Union were in the Brotherhood of Railway Running Trades Union which was granted a certificate of registry in 1959. In the years following its inception the union failed to achieve its objective, which was to represent the running trades on the CNR and CPR. In 1967 Leslie N. Falle was elected national president of the Brotherhood by a full referendum vote of all the membership. At this time, the union was suffering a significant loss of membership and, consequently, revenue, which posed a threat to its future.

At a legally constituted convention held at North Bay, Ontario in May 1971 the name was changed to the Transportation Employees Canadian Union by the membership, under the direction of Mr. Falle. A new constitution was voted in to replace the former one. One of Mr. Falle's most significant objectives for the new union was to remove control of the international unions from Canadian railroad labour. Dues would no longer be diverted to the United States. It was hoped that the existing 17 unions would be unified under a single charter. This central body would co-ordinate negotiations of all trades, reducing the costs of negotiations. The constitution allowed for the raiding of the international unions simultaneously, the mandate being to "enrol any person employed by a company in transportation." These goals were not to be realized, and the available evidence indicates that the union effectively ceased to function in the late 1970's. Neither the immediate cause of its failure, or the result of this failure is available to me at present. Mr. George Brandak, Manuscript Curator at UBC Special Collections, is making enquiries of union officials. According to information from printed constitutions, the past presidents of TECU were: Frederick H. Hall, 1957-1967; Leslie N. Falle, 1967-1976. As of the 1975 amendment, the National President was Douglas C. Drummond.
