## Introduction

The fonds of Walter Sheppe cover the years 1959 to 1965. The fonds consists of 25cm of textual records and 145 photographs. The records were donated to University of British Columbia Library, Special Collections and University Archives Division in 1991 by Walter Sheppe.

## Biographical Note

Sir Alexander Mackenzie made his expedition across North America in 1793. His journal of that trip was published in 1801. After spending two months retracing the Mackenzie route, Walter Sheppe a University Lecturer, published an annotated version of Mackenzie's journal in 1962.

## Scope and Content Note

Walter Sheppe fonds consists of subject files, correspondence, photographs, reviews and research notes of Walter Sheppe relating to his book on "First Man West: Alexander Mackenzie's account of his expedition across North America to the Pacific in 1793.
