Fonds Description

Supplied Title: Wood and English Ltd. Fonds. Physical Description: 6 cm of textual material [1 ledger]. Dates of Creation: 1940.

Administrative History: Wood and English Ltd was a lumber and sawmill company which operated in the small town of Englewood on Vancouver Island's north eastern coast. The company existed from approximately 1925 to 1945.

Scope and Content: Fonds consists of 1 financial ledger book which details an appraisal conducted of Wood and English's physical assets in 1940. The appraisal was conducted by the General Appraisal Company and lists the value of assets in Wood and English's various operations. These operations include: "saw mill," "power house," "planning mill," "sorting transfer shed" and "hog house."
