Ottawa, May 18, 1938.

Sirs:

The Chief Inspector of Customs, Ottawa, Ont.,
having reported on the 7th day of May 1938,
that the following facts have been ascertained upon
investigation, viz.:

That since the 27th April, 1937, you imported from
Germany 10600 spring beard needles, valued at
\$154.61 more or less; and the following charges for
infractions of the Customs laws having been made
against you, viz.:

That the actual selling price of the said goods to
the importer was such as to render the goods subject
to special or dumping duty, the payment of which was
evaded.

(Amount of deposit \$44.52)

Wherefore take notice that if such Seizure or charges
be maintained, the said goods or moneys, if accepted
on deposit in respect thereof, become liable to for-
feiture, and each party concerned in such infraction
of the law subject to penalties under the provisions
thereof.
