Dear Mr. Clark:

In reply to your letter dated January 26, 1976, the Union cannot agree to the job descriptions of Keypunch Operator I and Keypunch Operator II as they are contrary to the Letter of Understanding of the Collective Agreement and, furthermore, contradict Article 31, section 1 (A). We are also in disagreement with the Keypunch Trainee job description.

The Union does not agree to the Pay Grade III assigned to the job description of Senior Keypunch Operator as it is contrary to Article 36.01 of the collective agreement.

We are in agreement with the Keypunch Supervisor job description as presented.

The Union position was reached after discussions with the employees whose jobs are affected by the new job descriptions. We will be willing to discuss our main objections and our recommendations at your earliest convenience.
