"Made in Canada" Rulings

Ruling, File No. 86550, GS 247, as incorporated in Appraisers' Bulletin No. 3856, is hereby amended as follows:—

Special Steels, as follows, are of a class or kind made in Canada.

Tool and High Speed Steels; Magnet; Stainless; Hollow Mining Drill Steel; Hollow Stay Bolt Steel; Special Machinery Steels; Jail Bar and Bank Vault Steel; Ball Race and Bearing Steel; Air Hardening Die Steel; Oil Hardening Non-Shrinking Die Steels; Special Analysis Alloy Steels.

As Ruled in Appraisers' Bulletin No. 3856

Ingots (all sizes)
Billets up to 10" square
Rounds, hammered, up to 9" diam.,
(and) Flats, hammered, in equivalent section,
Rounds, rolled, up to 3½" diam.,
(and) Flats, rolled, in equivalent section, up
to 4" wide.
Rounds, cold drawn, up to 2½" diam.,
(and) Flats, cold drawn, in equivalent section.
Forged rings (all sizes)
Forged discs (all sizes)
Rounds, centerless ground, up to 1½" diam.
Polished carbon, high speed, and oil
hardening drill rod steels in a full
range of sizes.

As Now Defined

Up to 24" x 26" cross section.
Up to 12" square.
Up to 10" diam.,
in equivalent section.
4" diam. up to 6" diam.,
in equivalent sections up to 6" wide.

 $\frac{1}{8}$ " diam. up to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " diam., in equivalent section. Up to 30" diam. Up to 24" diam. $\frac{1}{8}$ " diam. up to $1\frac{7}{8}$ " diam.

Forged blocks up to 16" x 16" x 14"

In accordance with the Government's undertaking to give "adequate notice" to parties concerned in the event of transferring goods from the category of "a class or kind not made in Canada" to that of "a class or kind made in Canada," the ruling as applicable to the increased sizes and the new item (forged blocks) shall not become effective on importations until three weeks from the date hereof.
