

Cable to Eileen Daily. <sup>Monday 22 July</sup>

As a result of: 1) today's overwhelming rejection of the univ. Administration's latest wage offer by the AUCE membership, & 2) the subsequent near unanimous decision to hold a referendum strike vote if the latest union counter-proposal is not accepted, & 3) the ambiguity of the prov. govt.'s position with regards to AUCE & the provision of funds outside the regular univ. budget to meet a negotiated wage increase, & in view of the deteriorating situation which continues at UBC, the union again requests a meeting with yourself, The Premier Mr. David Barrett, & the Min. of Labour Mr. William King to discuss these matters and the issues raised in our letter of July 11, 1974.
