Dear Sir:

Thank you very kindly for the time and attention which you have given me yesterday afternoon in connection with the possibility of increasing the trade between the Dominion of Canada and Germany.

I take pleasure to enclose a copy of the questionnaire which the U.S. Customs require since January 3rd for each entry of German goods in this country. I have answered the various questions, as it is done by all American importers using the procedure as explained to you yesterday. It must, however, be born in mind that the U.S. Treasury Department requires particularly, that only such funds be used for the payment of German goods which have originally and continuously belonged to the importer who is using them to pay for his German purchases.

If there is any additional information which you require, please do not hesitate to communicate with me.
