Dear Miss Bilodeau:

I spoke to Rod Germaine, Vice-Chairman of the Labour Relations Board of B.C. last week regarding my letter to him of October 28, 1981.

On the basis that the union did not make a formal application to have the Board determine when back union dues should be payable from, Mr. Germaine persuaded me to accept union dues from you from September 1981 and on. He told me that we could make a formal application and in fact that you would have to pay union dues from last December in that case. Between the two of us we decided this was too much trouble. However, he further advised me that the union agreeing to arrangement that you pay dues from September does not prejudice us in any other cases nor does it prejudice our contract language with respect to the payment of union dues.

Therefore will you sign the dues authorization card and return it to Employee Relations. Our secretary-treasurer advises me that you have been deducted a total of \$65.00 to date. If we apply this amount to union dues starting in September you will be paid up until the end of January, 1982. Union dues are \$12.00 monthly but were \$17.00 in October to cover the annual \$5.00 strike assessment. I will forward a copy of this letter to Employee Relations in order that they can direct Finance to deduct dues from you commencing in February 1982. When I receive a copy of your dues authorization form I shall add your name to our mailing list and forward a union card to you.
