With further reference to our conversation about worm-geared Chain Blocks from Gebr. Bolzani, G.m.b.h., Germany, we wrote them recently asking for their present prices and as we were running low in worm-geared Hoists we took the liberty of sending them an order based on the old prices. To-day we received a letter from them, and in each instance they have increased the prices as follows:

Worm-geared Chain Blocks,-1/2-ton, new price RM

1/2-ton, new price RM 22.05 last shipment RM 18.20
1- " " 27.70 " " 22.90
1-1/2 " " 32.15 " " 26.50
2-ton " 41.60 " " 32.25

As you know on the last shipment there was dumping duty imposed, which we decided to pay, amounting to \$68.38. At the present time, what we cannot understand is that we placed an order originally with them based on their quotation. The Chain Hoists were satisfactory, but through their showing the "Fair Market Value as sold for Home Consumption," at a different price, we had to pay extra duty on the shipment. Now on the second order they increase the prices as above. Is it because that they want to get started with us that they quote a low price in the first instance, and then decide to increase the prices the next time? Probably the third time there will be another increase. If this is the way they do business, then we will have to look elsewhere for our source of supply. We cannot imagine that prices sedvance so often in Germany, because
