Re: Youth Employment Opportunity Program

In response to your letter of May 12, 1982 concerning the above program, the Union sees no need for a meeting on this matter.

We have made our position on the program known to the University for at least the last three years and it has not changed.

The type of work we see being done by this type of program would be special projects not normally done by our members. Our stipulations would be that the work would be a one shot project for which the University would not normally have funds available. Our only concern is that the students hired be paid at bargaining unit rates for the work done.

We have corresponded with the University in the past over the person doing work in the Computing Centre Reading Room as well as a project the Medical Genetics*wanted approval for in 1981.
