In reply to your inquiry of November 19th, I beg to say that this Consulate General is not in a position to give authentic information with regard to German customs duties. In order to obtain authentic information, you would have to apply to the German Customs Authorities through the mediation of the Canadian Trade Commissioner in Hamburg, Mr. L.D.Wilgress, Hamburg, Gutrufhaus, Neuer Wall 10.

Without obligation I would say, however, that the rate of duty on fur trimmed coats is 900 Marks per 100 kilos, or 9 M. per kilo.
