Dear Sir:

We have been purchasing considerable quantities of **ALUMINUM** Foil from Wolf Netter, Ludwigshafen am Rhein, Germany. This **ALUMINUM** is spooled on Iron Cores, -- we are contemplating returning these cores, as well as End Pieces and Felt Pads used for packing purposes, --- these of course will be used over again in forthcoming shipments.

In order to facilitate the return of these cores, End pieces and Felt Pads, et cetera to **GERMANY**, we thought it would be advisable to communicate with you and ascertain the best method of handling this return shipment. You no doubt can give us information to expedient this matter.

We might state that we have 12 (twelve) cases containing approximately 2000 Iron Cores, as well as 1500 Pads ready for shipment.

A reply would be appreciated.
