To Collectors of Customs and Excise,

BINDER TWINE

Section 4 of the regulations established by the Minister of Agriculture under the authority of the Inspection and Sale Act, 1938, (Chapter 32) provides that a signed statement of the shipper or importer, in triplicate, shall be attached to the invoice for customs purposes, covering every shipment of binder twine for importation into Canada.

Collectors of Customs and Excise are required to forward one copy of the signed statement to the nearest Plant Products Division Inspection Office, and shall not release importations of binder twine for delivery until authority for such release is received from an inspector designated under the Inspection and Sale Act.
