I had just learned this at noon and in my rush to advise her as soon as possible did not ask her permission or request the leave and was left a memo to the effect that you do not "tell" your supervisor anything, but request is another matter for her to decide whether or not it would be feasible. My concern was 1) my daughter's well-being and 2) to advise her as soon as possible. Sent a note of apology for the mistake in the choice of words/phrasing but was under duress/strain and did not think of choosing the words, please, ask, or request.
