consist of a lease of an unexpired term of  
5 years of about 8 acres of land adjoining  
Beacon Hill subject to a rent of \$42<sup>50</sup> per  
annum. and 8 head of stock 4 pigs and  
some furniture which are of the estimated  
value of \$350 or thereabouts subject to a  
mortgage in favor of James Ward for \$600<sup>00</sup>  
which said mortgage is now due.
